Questions to consider include: Why was she famous? Where did she come from? What did she like to play when she was little? What job did she have first? What was she the first female pilot to do? What was her first plane called and why? What did she dream of doing? What happened to her? You can choose the way in which you present your work – you could pretend to write a newspaper article about her, draw and write, create artwork or make a video of yourself telling us what you found out.
