You will need to choose **three** pieces from the 'menu' below to complete over the half term-one **from each column**. After you have completed each one, bring it back to school. The 'Peri-ometer' shows the difficulty or challenge the homework may offer. It can even be a photograph or drawing of something you have done. All your three pieces need to be done by October half term. I will still be sending out weekly Maths homework each Friday to be completed by the following Wednesday. Spellings will be given on Fridays to be learnt for a test on Thursday.



Art, design and technology	Science - Forces and Magnets	History - Stone Age to Iron Age
Create a model of a Stone Age house.	Design and make a game using magnets	Create a leaflet for 'How to survive in the Stone Age'. What would you need to know if you travelled back in time to the Stone Age?
Create a poster showing Stone Age tools	Find examples of forces in action around your home e.g. pulling the curtains. Design a poster showing this force in action.	Create a comic strip showing a typical day in the Stone Age. Think about what they would do e.g. hunting, making weapons and tools.
Design a new menu for stewed fruit - what fruit would you include? Can you make it (take a photo)	Write a list of magnetic and nonmagnetic items.	Invent an outfit for a Stone Age man or woman. Think about the materials that were available to them.
Draw a Stone Age animal	Design a poster showing examples of pushes and pulls.	Cave art pictures
