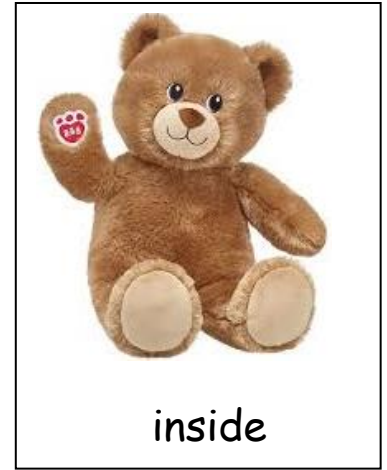


Outdoor activities - Autumn 2
